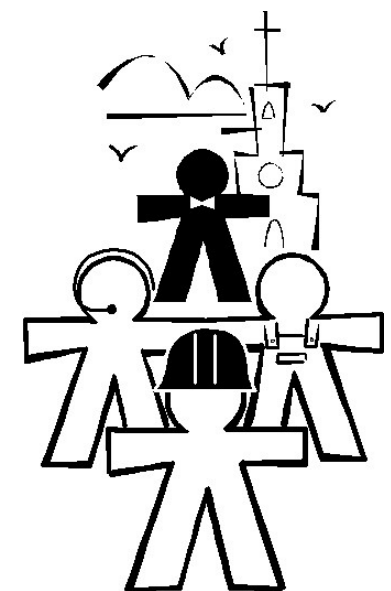

Session I is an overview of the structure and process of RCIA. The interview process will be covered.

Session II will provide an overview of the Rite of Acceptance with some modeling of the ritual as well an overview of the Catechumenate.

Session III will provide an overview of the Rite of Sending/Rite of Election with the Scrutinies and some modeling of how these rituals look.

Session IV is an overview of optional rites within the one-to-three-year period of preparation and catechesis, Holy Saturday events, and the Initiation

Session V will provide an overview of Mystagogia, the time immediately after initiation as well as the rest of the neophyte's life.

Sessions rotate to various host parishes. Completion of this 5-part series will result in a basic understanding of all aspects of RCIA, a certificate of completion, and a letter to your Pastor confirming completion. You may attend the sessions in any order, although we recommend sequential attendance.
